01 SANTA ROSA SAUVIGNON BLANC

Central Valley, Chile, 2010/11

This is an exceptionally well made Sauvignon Blanc, with apples and grass on the nose balanced with crisp, zesty acidity and a luscious clean finish.

02 VIGNOBLE DU SUD CHARDONNAY

Vin de France, France, 2010

This easy drinking, fruit driven Chardonnay is produced in a new world style. Delivering plenty of tropical fruit with a creamy finish.

03 SANTA ROSA MERLOT

Central Valley, Chile, 2010/11

This Merlot is fresh and fruity, bursting with typical flavours of ripe plums and cherries - smooth and easy to drink.

06 BERONIA , RIOJA ROSADO

34 TORREON DE PAREDES LATE HARVEST GEWURZTRAMINER RESERVA

125ml £5.50 37.5cl bottle £12.95

Valle de Rengo, Chile, 2008

A sweet wine made from harvesting overripe Gewurztraminer grapes followed by a delicate fermentation and maturation during 12 months in French oak barrels. Golden yellow in colour, with elegant aromas of candied orange and honey, the sweetness on the palate is balanced and refined.

35 SAUTERNES, RESERVE, DULONG

50cl Bottle £18.95

Bordeaux, France, 2009

Rich, golden yellow colour with a powerful and racy bouquet of beeswax and honey. Rich, well-balanced and persistent in the mouth with fig and apricot flavours. Ideal with foie gras, blue cheeses, white and dark chocolate or dishes made with honey.

29 LECONFIELD SYN CUVÉE BLANC, MCLAREN VALE

Australia, NV

Elegant soft fruit palate in a drier style, and finishing with a clean acid finish.

30 BOTTER PROSECCO DI VALDOBBIADENE, DOCG

Bottle £23.00

Italy, NV

Straw shade of yellow reflecting spring rays of sunshine and the flavour is harmoniously balanced with delicate fruity notes, a low acidity and a moderate alcohol content.

Prosecco should be consumed when still young to fully appreciate the sparkle (perlage), fragrance and flavour.

31 CRUSE BRUT ROSÉ

Bottle £22.00

France NV

Partner to the easy drinking White, the Rosé is an extremely tempting salmon pink colour, with soft, summer fruits and good well balanced acidity on the palate.

32 LAURENT-PERRIER, BRUT 75CL

Bottle £50.00

Champagne, France, NV

A blend of 45% Chardonnay, 40% Pinot Noir & 15% Pinot Meunier. This Champagne has a delicate and fresh nose, with good complexity and notes of citrus, Caramel and toasted Brioche. It is fresh and supple upon entry with rounded and expressive flavours from which the fruit progressively emerges. Good balance and length. IWC Commended, DWWA Silver

33 LAURENT PERRIER, BRUT ROSÉ

Bottle £70.00

Champagne, France, NV

This iconic Champagne is the undisputed leader in the rosé Champagne category. It is famous for its highly expressive bouquet, which stems from the very careful preservation of the grape's natural fresh red fruit aromas.

RED WINE

07 BORDEAUX ROUGE, ALEXIS LICHINE

Bottle £18.50

France, 2009

A round and fleshy wine with velvety tannins, dark berries and plummy fruits offering body but with a smooth soft finish.

08 VALDEMORO CABERNET SAUVIGNON

Bottle £17.50

Chile, 2009/10

This juicy, full bodied Cabernet Sauvignon has dark fruit flavours and a rich finish.

09 DOÑA VICTORINA TEMPRANILLO

Bottle £17.50

Spain, 2009

Delicious Tempranillo with bags of juicy fruit and intense aromas. This is well balanced with soft tannins making it very pleasant to drink on its own or with food.

10 TORREÓN DE PAREDES CARMENERE RESERVA

Bottle £20.00

Valle de Rengo, Chile, 2008/09

Aromas of black ripe fruits, cherries, blackberries, cassis with black chocolate and vanilla notes from the oak ageing. The palate is round, supple and complex with firm tannins that ensure it's potential for ageing gracefully in the bottle.

11 ALTA GLORIA, MALBEC

Bottle £20.00

Mendoza, Argentina, 2009

Surprisingly, this Malbec is relatively easy drinking in style compared to more traditional styles of Malbec. The wine has black fruit flavours and big chunky tannins.

12 ROBERT SKALLI PINOT NOIR

Bottle £24.00

South of France, 2008

Deep ruby red in colour with aromas of bilberry and spice. Intense flavours of small black fruit, chocolate and liquorice give wonderful complexity to this smooth, delicious wine.

13 STILL BAY PINOTAGE

Bottle £18.00

South Africa, 2010/11

Soft smoky flavours with plum and cherry fruit, a great example of Pinotage.

14 BERONIA, RIOJA, CRIANZA

Bottle £21.00

Spain, 2007

Made from 82% Tempranillo, 14% Garnacha and 4% Mazuelo. The wine is aged 12 months in barrel and 12 months in bottle prior to release. Aromas of vanilla, raspberry and cherry dominate the bouquet. The palate is fresh and fruity with a rich and powerful finish. IWC Commended

- 15 **BOTTER, AMARONE DELLA VALPOLICELLA, CLASSICO, DOC**
Bottle £35.00
Veneto, Italy, 2005
Amarone is the result of loft-drying selected grapes before pressing to produce a highly-concentrated wine, the climax of every Veronese feast!
- 16 **PÈRE ANSELME CHÂTEAUNEUF DU PAPE ROUGE RESERVE, BROTTÉ**
Bottle £35.00
Rhone Valley, France, 2009
Deep ruby-red colour. Complex nose with aromas of ripe fruits, morello cherries, venison, truffle and cedar tree. Natural tannic structure.
- 17 **LECONFIELD CABERNET SAUVIGNON,**
Bottle £30.00
Coonawarra, Australia, 2008
Full and ripe, the 2008 vintage displays everything that a classic Coonawarra Cabernet Sauvignon should display - intense cassis fruit, augmented with fine cedar and cinnamon nuances from predominantly French oak. DWVA Bronze

- 18 **KATHERINE HILLS UNOAKED CHARDONNAY**
Bottle £19.00
South Australia, 2010
As this wine has no oak contact, the result is a fruit driven style full of luscious tropical fruits.
- 19 **STILL BAY CHENIN BLANC**
Bottle £17.00
South Africa, 2010/11
South Africa's classic white grape varietal, this Chenin Blanc has mouth-watering tropical fruits balanced by a racy acidity.
- 20 **DOÑA VICTORINA, VERDEJO SAUVIGNON BLANC**
Bottle £20.00
Spain, 2009
Unoaked white wine made from 50% Verdejo and 50% Sauvignon, vinified at low temperatures to maximise freshness. Deliciously dry and zesty with delicate tropical fruit aromas and crisp citrus flavours. Ideal with all types of seafood.
- 21 **BOTTER CA'LUNGHETTA, PINOT GRIGIO, IGT**
Bottle £17.00
Veneto, Italy, 2009/10
This light and refreshing wine is produced in the Venetian region. An elegant bouquet with hints of ripe fruits and flowers, the palate is dry, soft and well-balanced with a full bodied structure of refreshing fruit.

- 22 **TORREÓN DE PAREDES SAUVIGNON BLANC RESERVA**
Bottle £19.00
Valle de Rengo, Chile, 2008/09
Made and aged in French oak barrels for 8 months. Bright yellow colour with a touch of green. Citrus aromas mingle with hints of honey and vanilla. A complex wine, balanced and mineral finish.
- 23 **VINEA, GARGANEGA, IGT**
Bottle £20.00
Veneto, Italy, 2009/10
Most famous for producing Soave, this Garganega has intense aromas of almond blossom, orange zest and vanilla dominate the nose. This stunning wine is full bodied with ripe fruit, clean acidity and a long finish with mineral notes. IWSC Silver - Best in Class
- 24 **ROBERT SKALLI VIOGNIER, VIN DE PAYS D'OC**
Bottle £22.00
France, 2009
A deliciously aromatic white, this varietal is traditionally grown in the Rhone Valley. This is full of peaches and apricots with a slightly toasted finish.
- 25 **CHABLIS, RÉSERVE DE MONTAIGU, J. MOREAU ET FILS**
Bottle £28.00
Burgundy, France, 2009/10
The vines grow on gentle slopes along the perimeter of the Chablis Grand Cru and Premier Cru appellations. Pale gold in colour with slight green tinges and a fruity nose with butter and hazelnut aromas.
- 26 **SANCERRE, DOMAINE BONNARD**
Bottle £30.00
Loire Valley, France, 2009/10
A fresh and vivacious Sancerre, with lots of zesty fruit, good acidity and a long finish. It has an excellent balance between weight of fruit and acidity.
- 27 **LOUIS LATOUR CHARDONNAY GRAND ARDÈCHE, VIN DE PAYS DES CÔTEAUX DE L'ARDÈCHE**
Bottle £35.00
France, 2008/09
Oak-aged for ten months, the wine has a clear, golden-yellow colour and a powerful, elegant bouquet of vanilla, exotic fruits, honey and subtle spices. Wonderfully rounded and fleshy on the palate, it displays honey and gingerbread flavours that persist in the mouth.
- 28 **Craggy Range Te Muna Road Sauvignon Blanc, Martinborough**
Bottle £30.00
New Zealand, 2008/09
Wonderfully complex Sauvignon Blanc with aromas of nectarine and floral notes. The palate is packed with stone fruit, lime and grapefruit with mineral characters. The finish is long, crisp and clean.
